
What is APL (Accreditation of Prior Learning)?

We may be able to award you credit towards your UCR qualification for qualifications and experience gained elsewhere, up to a maximum of two-thirds of the credits required for your qualification.

APCL: If you have a certificate (or transcript) confirming a relevant prior qualification at level 4+, we may be able to accredit this as certificated learning (APCL). There is no charge for this. The qualification must be no more than 5 years old, unless you can demonstrate you have kept your skills up-to-date.

APEL: We may also be able to credit your experience (APEL). You will have to pay a charge to UCR for assessment. **APEL credit may not exceed 50% of that required for your qualification.**
