What is a postponement?

The University Centre has a policy of allowing students who may experience unexpected circumstances to postpone (interrupt) their studies for a limited period of time. **Note:** there is no automatic right to postponement.

Example circumstances: health circumstances, significant changes in life circumstances, family bereavement, once in a lifetime opportunities related to career aspirations and/ or programmes of study, or where you are exempt from placement but you wish to remain with your original cohort. These are all possible justifications for a postponement, but the granting of a postponement is always at the discretion of your Course Manager.

Normally, students are only permitted to postpone their studies for a maximum of one academic year.

It is important to be aware that if you do decide to postpone there may be financial implications. You are **strongly advised** to contact your funding provider to get clear advice based on your current position.

How do I apply for a postponement?
